Item Title:		Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area Millage Request		
Action Taken by Committee previously:		The Committee approved an increase in the ad valorem tax levy for the Glassy Mountain Fire Service Area in 2022 – Ordinance 5419.		
Motion Requested Today:		Glassy Mountain Fire requests an increase in the FSA's operational tax rate of 2.6 mills that represents a CPI and population growth of 10.52% as allowed per Section 6-1-320A of the South Carolina Code of Laws. Glassy Mountain is also requesting approval to issue General Obligation bonds not exceeding \$400,000 to replace aging equipment and allow necessary improvements. The FSA is requesting an increase in debt millage of approximately 1 mill.
