AGRICULTURAL SPECIAL ASSESSMENT:

This is a request to grant an extension of application period for agricultural assessment for the Travelers Rest Historical Society. The agricultural special assessment effectively reduces the assessed value of property used for agricultural purposes.

John Hansley, Deputy County Administrator was present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Tripp moved to approve granting an extension of application period for agricultural assessment for the Travelers Rest Historical Society. The motion carried unanimously.

AMENDMENT TO ROAD MAINTENANCE FEE ORDINANCE:

This is an amendment to the Road Maintenance Fee Ordinance as it relates to the definition of County Road System. Amending the ordinance provides that "County road system" may include all roads in the County owned or maintained by the County, the State of South Carolina or any political subdivision or agency thereof.

John Hansley, Deputy County Administrator and Mark Tollison, County Attorney were present to answer questions of the committee.

Councilor Seman moved to approve the amendment to the Road Maintenance Fee Ordinance. The motion carried unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

PROJECT PERIGEE:


Councilor Seman moved to approve an ordinance authorizing the execution and delivery of a FILOT agreement and Special Source Credit Agreement by and between Greenville County and Project Perigee. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilor Tripp commented that he was glad to see a local company benefiting from the tax incentives offered through a FILOT agreement.
