Dear Mr. Kernell:

Boiling Springs Fire District respectfully requests that the Greenville County Council, per its authority under State Law [Section 6-1-320(A)], adopt a resolution authorizing the District to increase its current millage by 2.8 mills for operations and maintenance, to meet the operational needs of the District for fiscal year 2023-2024.

The budget for fiscal year 2023-2024 calls for revenues of \$5,849,047 and expenditures of \$6,316,800. There is an increase in the operating budget from fiscal year 2022-2023 to 2023-2024, due primarily to increased healthcare costs, inflation, and other government mandated costs.

Enclosed is a Resolution from the Commission approving the millage request, along with a copy of our Enabling Act. We very much appreciate your assistance in this matter.
