**Re:** Adoption of Paris Mountain Wildfire Mitigation Plan

Greenville County is threatened by a number of natural hazards that endanger the health and safety of the population, jeopardize its economic vitality, and imperil the quality of its environment. To help mitigate these hazards, Greenville County adopted the 2020 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP). The HMP outlines mitigation planning activities designed to reduce the impact of natural hazards on the community.

Within the HMP, one of the tasks was to prepare a Wildfire Plan for the Paris Mountain area. Greenville County was able to obtain Federal Grant funds to assist with the preparation of this plan. In accordance with the Grant, the Paris Mountain Wildfire Mitigation Plan must now be adopted by County Council and incorporated into the existing 2020 HMP.

Therefore, we respectfully request that the RIPW Committee forward this resolution to a public hearing and for adoption by Council. An adopting resolution and the full plan with executive summary is attached.
