Dear Mrs. Farnsworth:

With reference to your letter dated April 13, 1966,
addressed to Mr. Ferd. Rieger, with regard to Federal Document-
ary Stamps in connection with the deed from Texaco Inc. to
Statewide Stations, Inc., previously forwarded to you for re-
cordation, I am enclosing a Xerox copy of opinion dated March 14,
1966, prepared by Mr. James F. Birmingham of Texaco Inc.'s Tax
Department.

A reading of this opinion will indicate that for
Federal tax purposes the deed from Texaco Inc. to Statewide
Stations, Inc. is treated as a mortgage and that the Federal
Documentary Stamp Tax does not apply.

You have previously received Texaco Inc.'s check
covering the recording fee and South Carolina Documentary
Stamps, and on the basis of the attached opinion, it is reques-
ted that subject deed be filed of record in your office with-
out the necessity of attaching Federal Documentary Stamps
thereto.
