having given me note for the amount due, as aforesaid. It is agreed that time is of the essence of this contract, and if said payments of every kind be not made when due The Globe Optical Co. shall be discharged in law and equity from all liability to make said deed, and may treat said H. F. Welborn as tenant holding over after termination, or contrary to the terms of his lease, and shall be entitled to claim and recover, or retain if already paid the sum of Three Hundred Twenty (\$320.00) dollars per year for rent, or by way of liquidated damages, or may enforce payment of said note.
