DEED TO E. Agnew Webster,

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Annie C. Webster, of Greenville County

in consideration of the sum of Five dollars (and natural love and affection for my Son, the grantee.) in the State aforesaid to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. Agnew Webster, of Greenville County, S.C. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said E. Agnew Webster: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid containing two and one half (2-1/2) acres, more or less, according to a plat by W.D. Neves, dated July 6, 1912; and being a part of my present home place. The lot herein conveyed is known as No. 3 on said plat and has the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: Beginning at an iron pin ( north corner of Lot No. 2) and running thence along Lot No. 2, S. 45° 20' W. two hundred and seventy-four (274) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42 W. four hundred and sixty five (465) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51° 30' E. two hundred and forty-two (242) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46° 30' E. four hundred and twenty-nine (429) feet to the beginning point.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said E. Agnew Webster, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said E. Agnew Webster, and his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
