KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville Trust Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina ... and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other valuable 1 DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mabel Lee

Stover, Her Heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, in said County and State, and on north side of Franklin Road, near the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Franklin Road 350.10 feet to east of Sunbeam Road, and running thence N. 64° 46' E. 319.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19° 29' E. 591.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77° 05' E 349.8 feet to a point in ditch, thence S. 17° 20' W. 881 feet to an iron pin on Franklin Road; thence N. 83° 10' W. 277.90 to the beginning corner being the same lot of land conveyed to G. W. Douglass by J. P. Benson by his deed bearing date the 1st day of April, 1915, and recorded in the L. P. C. Office for said county and State, in Vol. 27, at page 561; and by G. W. Douglass Conveyed to the Greenville Trust Company in consideration of a sum of \$1000, being the sum due on the 1st day of April, 1916 said deed to be yet recorded. 54/90

There is a mortgage on the above described land for \$1025. dated June 2nd, 1915, wherein one year from the date, given by, is to commence payment to S. S. Boddy, etc., a sum of \$50 per month, to be paid quarterly, the interest to bear from and after the date of payment, and so continuing until the same becomes due. I agree to assume same.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers,

on this the 24th day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and in the one hundred and forty-first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
