 in the State of *South Carolina* for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Hundred (\$500.00)* DOLLARS,
 to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto *A. C. Johnson*

Johnson, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina in East Overbrook known as lot No. 14 on plat made by W. D. Newland, recorded in Plat Book C, page 274, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Central St. and running thence N. 30°-58' W. one hundred and ninety-three & seven tenths feet to an iron pin; thence N. 46°-10' E. one hundred and forty-five and three tenths feet to an iron pin corner of lot 14 and 16; thence S. 37°-41' E. one hundred and ninety & four and five tenths feet to an iron pin on Central St. thence with said St. one hundred and twenty-two feet and three tenths to an iron pin the beginning corner, being one hundred and twenty-two & three tenths feet from the corner of Park road and Central St. Being a portion of land conveyed to Greenville Real Estate Loan & Ins.
