a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States, and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other Valuable DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto.....

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at iron pin at corner of W. D. Brownings lot and running thence along North Main Street N. 14° 30' E. 105' feet to an iron pin at corner of North Main Street and Elford Street; thence along Elford Street N. 62° 33' W. 147' feet to corner of lot no. 2 on Elford Street; thence along line of lot no. 2 S. 26° 10' E. 101.9 feet to point in line of W. D. Brownings lot; thence along the line of W. D. Brownings lot S. 62° 33' E. 154.7 feet to iron pin at the beginning corner. Being known and designated as lot no. 1 according to survey and plat of the estate of John H. O'Reilly made by R. E.
