KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Hayler Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

G. F. Hinkle: All that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the north side of Cedar Lane Road known as Lot #5 on Plat made by F. K. Rogers; Beginning at a stake on said road 80 feet from the northwest corner of said road and Monroel street; thence N. 39 W. 60 feet; thence N. 51 E. 152 feet; thence S. 34 E. 32 feet; thence S. 45 W. 70 feet; thence S. 59 E. 20 feet; thence S. 47 W. 90 feet to the beginning, being one of the lots of land conveyed to the grantor by D. B. Trapler by Deed recorded in R. L. C. office for Greenville County, Deed Book 36, page 109.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

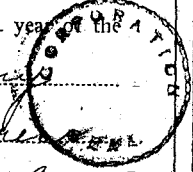
