KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Melville Land Company
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at
Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the
sum of One thousand \$1,000.00 DOLLARS,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

L. G. Fuerman and J. D. Westervelt,
the tract of land, being a lot bounded, situate, lying and
being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the
City of Greenville on the East side of Sumner Street, being
more particularly described as follows. Beginning at a stake on
the East side of Sumner Street 361.875 feet South of Ellingtonau
Street and Sumner Street corner of lot #5 and running thence
with Sumner Street S. 16.20 W. 3.66.625 feet to a stake, the
southern corner, lot No. 12, thence S. 75.30 E. 190.7 feet to
stake on a 20 foot alley; thence along the line of said Alley
N. 17 E. 358.19 feet to stake on said Alley, corner of lot #5,
thence along line of lot No. 5 N. 71.13 W. 193.93 feet to the
beginning corner being lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in
Block N. of the property of Greenville Land Company,

premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and
heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof.
