a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and seventy DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee...

L.H. Cary and Floride S. Hiller, All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being, in Subdivision known as West Park, just outside the City of Greenville, S.C., said lot being No. 9, as shown by plat of West Park, recorded in Plat Book C, page 79 and 80, R.M.C.
