KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. L. Massaway of the city
and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid and in consideration of the sum of three thousand (\$3,000.00) DOLLARS
other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Christine Holliday (the receipt whereof is here-
by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
Christine Holliday and her heirs and assigns forever, one of that certain lieve-
reel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County
of Greenville in Greenville Township on the White Horse road and having according to a Survey and Plat
thereof made by J. N. Southern Surveyor, dated 9th day of August, 1914, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County and
State in Plat book "A", at page 166, the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a iron post on the West
side of the White Horse road and running thence S. 69 1/4 E. 4.50 to a stone and iron 3x0, thence S. 24 3/4 W. 4.00
to a stone 3x0 for R.O., thence N. 64 1/2 W. 3.65 to a stone and iron 3x0, thence S. 23 1/2 W. 6.30 to a stone and iron 3x0
thence S. 64 1/2 E. 9.00 to an iron 3x0 in a gully, thence on the same degree S. 64 1/2 E. 8.46 to an iron 3x0
thence N. 52 1/2 E. 5.50 to an iron 3x0, thence N. 13 1/2 E. 1.07 to an iron 3x0; thence N. 64 1/2 W. 3.82 to an iron
3x0, thence N. 54 1/2 E. 3.00 to an iron 3x0 on the West side of White Horse road, thence along the west
side of said White Horse Road as the line N. 33 W. 3.89 to a heel in said road (iron 3x0); thence
S. 30 W. 3.89 along the west side of said road to the beginning corner, containing fifteen and
one fourth (15 1/4) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Mr. Hugh Pison, Conyers and Gower, Welcome Church
and White Horse road, a being also known and designated as lots nos. 2 and 3 according to a plat made by J. N.

Christine Holliday and her heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

Christine Holliday and her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
