 by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
 City of Greenville, S.C. all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville  
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the city of  
 Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds which  
 land is now occupied by a street 50' wide. Beginning at a  
 point on line between property of Wilkins Eagle and H.B. Tindal  
 and property of S.K. Tindal which point is the center line of a  
 street extending through aforesaid property and running N. 89-1/2 E.  
 961 feet to property line of S.K. Tindal on Jones Ave. Said street ex-  
 tending 25' feet on either side of the above described center line
