WHEREAS, V. B. and Arthur Ramsey, and Oscar R. Mauldin, of Greenville, S. C. did on the 8th day of June, 1921, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

First: The names and residences of the said petitioners to be as above stated;  
Second: The name of the proposed corporation be that of Greenville Spool and Manufacturing Company INCORPORATED IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, THE CAPITAL STOCK OF THE SAID CORPORATION HAS BEEN THIS DAY INCREASED TO THE SUM OF Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars GIVEN UNDER MY HAND AND THE SEAL OF THE STATE AT COLUMBIA, THE 18th DAY OF July, A. D. 1921.  
Third: The principal place of business of the corporation will be Greenville, S. C.

Fourth: The general purpose of the corporation, and the nature of business it proposes to do.  
To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire lands and buildings for the erection and establishment of manufacturing factories and workshops with suitable plants, engines and machinery. To manufacture, buy, sell, import, export, and generally deal in machinery, spools and all other articles pertaining to cotton mills, and every other article of all classes and description, and to generally have all powers conferred by law on similar corporations.

V. B. and Arthur Ramsey, of Greenville, S. C., and Oscar R. Ramsey, of Central, S. C. That subsequently there was elected as President, V. B. Ramsey as Vice President, Arthur Ramsey as Secretary, and Oscar R. Ramsey as Treasurer, V. B. Ramsey.  
Fifth: The amount of the capital stock to be Five thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars and the number of shares into which the same is to be divided to be One Hundred (100) Shares of the par value of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each.  
Sixth: The capital stock to be payable as set forth in the Declaration and Petition.

AND WHEREAS, on the 8th day of June, A. D. 1921, the date above named, petitioners were commissioned by me a Board of Corporators;  
AND WHEREAS, the said Board of Corporators, on the 13th day of June, 1921, did file with the Secretary of State their return in writing, over their signatures, certifying, among other things, that pursuant to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purpose indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W.
