

The following is an agreement between Robert A. Taylor, party of the first part, and Norris Brothers, Incorporated, parties of the second part, constituting the firm known as Norris Brothers, located at Greenville, State of South Carolina.

1 Party of the first part being the sole owner of certain United States Letters of Patent for Hand-Threading Shuttle, Patent No. 988294.

2 Party of the first part does hereby agree and grants exclusive privilege to Norris Brothers, parties of the second part, the right to manufacture and sell the said Shuttle south of the Mason and Dixon line and West of the Ohio River.

3 Parties of the second part agree to sell the Taylor Shuttle through all leading Supply Houses and furnish them with all necessary samples at all times.

4 Parties of the second part agree to advertise and push the Taylor Shuttle as their leading leading Shuttle; and also further agree not to advertise or recommend any other Hand-Threading Shuttle so long as this contract is in force.

5 Parties of the second part agree to use all first-class stock, materials, fittings, etc., and manufacture all Taylor Shuttles strictly in accordance with dimensions and specifications and to make all shipments promptly.

6 Party of the first part has the right to inspect and pass judgment on all shipments of the above named shuttle. In case the demand for the Taylor Shuttle should grow beyond the output of the present plant, Norris Brothers, parties of the second part, agree to install the necessary machinery to meet the demands and fill all orders promptly.

7 Parties of the second part FURTHER agree to manufacture and fill all orders out of the reserved territory contracted by parties of the second part, under the terms of this contract Provided, all such orders are agreed to, or signed by party of the first part.

8 Parties of the second part are to furnish party of the first part copies of all orders and invoices.

9 Parties of the second part are to bear all expenses in manufacturing and to pay for all supplies, transportation, etc., and pay to the said Robert A. Taylor, party of the first part, One Dollar (\$1.00) Royalty on each dozen Shuttles, until the output exceeds two hundred (200) dozen in one calendar month. When the output does exceed two hundred dozen (200) in one calendar month, the party of the first part is to receive ten per cent (10%) of the gross Invoices; and One Dollar (\$1.00) per dozen on all Invoices where the output is less than two hundred (200) dozen in one calendar month.

10 Parties of the second part agree to hold the price up to the standard and not to fill any orders below the regular price list of THE AMERICAN SHUTTLE COMPANY, charging One Dollar (\$1.00) extra for Threader, without special consent from party of the first part.

11 Parties of the second part do FURTHER guarantee and agree to pay all Royalty promptly each month. In case either party fails to comply strictly to this contract, the same will become null and void.

12 Parties of the second part Further agree not to sell any blanks to be fitted with the Taylor Threader without special consent from the party of the first part, and paying the full amount of Royalty on same.

THIS CONTRACT becomes effective on this date, and only includes orders entered from October 1st, 1915.
