The said Trustees shall have full power to sell the said property, and reinvest the fund for the same purpose as provided in the said constitution. And the Titles executed by them, or their Successors, or Survivors shall be good and valid, free from any question of use, limitations or reversion herein contained. But the same shall be charged upon any property purchased with said fund for the purposes of the said Institute in the same way.
