 along the roads, streets or highways adjoining
 the said property, with the right to trim all
 trees necessary to keep the wires clear at
 least eighteen inches, to set necessary guy and
 brace poles, and to attach to trees the necessary
 guy wires. Line to be built not to exceed 4'
 feet from road line, two trees to be cut,
