Janie Goldsmith Little her heirs and assigns, all of my right, title and interest and estate of in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned; to all of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, near Simpsonville, S.C., and adjoining lands of James Richardson, Wade Barton and others, being a part of the Real Estate of the late T.B. Goldsmith and Mary P.
