(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. T. Jenkinson: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on both sides of Laurel Creek, waters of Reedy River, containing thirteen and three quarter (13-3/4) acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a rock 3x NM on branch and running thence N. 9-1/2 W. 3.50 chains to a persimmon 3X NM; thence N. 31 W. 1.63 chains to a spring, corner in the Spring; thence due North 2.00 chains to three red oaks 3X NM on the road; thence N. 32-3/4 W. 2.90 chains to pine 3X NM; thence N. 45-1/2 2.40 chains to rock 3X NM; thence N. 4-3/4 W. 12.70 chains to a white oak 3X NM; thence S. 40.00 W. 12.00 chains to rock; thence S. 62 E. 3.37 chains to double pine 3X NM; thence S. 21-1/2 E. 6.56 chains to red-oak 3XNM; thence S. 32-1/2 E. 2.85 chains to a rock 3X on the said road; thence S. 5 E. 5.71 chains to rock 3X NM; thence N. 70-3/4 E. 1.76 chains to pine on road; thence to the beginning corner and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by H.L. Todd by deed bearing date the 14th. day of December 1914 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County in Book Vol. 26, at page 474.
