Johnson, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, about four miles North East of the city of Greenville, to-wit: Beginning center of Beverly Foad (see oak post on side) line of lot No. 4 & No. 5 and running thence, with Beverly Foad N. 75-04 W. 219.8 feet; thence N. 75-40 W. 219.3 feet; thence N. 72-35 W. 48.3 feet; thence N. 65-35 W. 136.7 feet to corner (see oak post line lots No. 7 & 8); thence with line of No. 7 & 8, N. 23-50 E. 762.4 feet to oak post; thence with heyward & Sepigle line S. 66-10 E. 618 feet to an oak post corner of John H. Williams; thence, with line of lot No. 4 & No. 5, S. 23-50 W. 688.3 feet to beginning corner and being all of lots No. 5, 6, & 7 sub-division Beverly Hill 1913; plat recorded Plat Book C. page 121, office R.M.C. Greenville County.
