(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged); have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A. E. Morris & T. G. Garrison, all that certain piece, parcel or lot
 of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
 and County of Greenville, in Bates Township on waters of Reedy River
 and on the Mucklehoney Road, to Madeline Reet, known and designated
 as tracts Nos. 4, 5 and 6 of the F. M. Edwards farm on a plat thereof made
 by Will D. Nevee, November 20th, 1913 and having according to such plat,
 the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on
 Mucklehoney Road on line of tract No. 3 and running thence N. 26°
 W. 43.40 chains to a stake on line of Hudgens lands, thence S. 63.55'
 W. 19.85 chains to a stone on line of Embanks lands, thence S. 21°30'
 E. 14.60 chains to a stone, thence S. 65° W. 9 chains to a stone
 on line of Embanks lands, thence S. 36° E. 37.70 chains to a
 sour wood tree, thence S. 31°45' E. 8.40 chains to a stake in
 old road, thence N. 59° 15' E. 2.14 chains to a stake in said
 old road, thence N. 50° E. 17.50 chains to a stake, thence N. 58° 15'
 E. 3 chains to the middle of Reedy River, thence with said
 River, N. 21° W. 5.50 chains to Center of Bridge crossing said River,
 thence N. 44° 30' E. 50 chains to a stake on the East side of the
 Mucklehoney Road, thence N. 42° 30' W. 3.50 chains to a stake,
 thence N. 0° 14.51' E. 2.95 chains to a stake at the beginning
 point. This being a part of the tract of land conveyed to me,
 the said F. M. Edwards by Joseph Edwards by deed bearing
 date June 20th, A.D. 1898 and recorded in the Office of R. M. C.
 for said County and State on the 2nd day of August, 1905 in
 book "0.0.0." of deeds at page 394. According to the above mentioned
 plot the premises hereby conveyed contain 143.6 acres, more or
 less. It is hereby expressly agreed between the grantor and
 grantees that the grantees, as a part of the consideration for this
 conveyance, shall and hereby do assume the payment of the
 balance due on the mortgage executed by the grantor to Jessie
 M. Marpley on February 28, 1913, and recorded in Book 31, page 27,
 which mortgage was originally given for \$6500.00, but the
 balance due and payable on same as of this date is \$1876.67;
 the grantees also hereby assume as a part of the consideration to
 this deed, the payment of the balance due on the mortgage executed by the
 grantor to J. A. League & Company on April 8, 1913, and recorded in
 Book 31, page 38, which mortgage was originally given for \$579.77, but
 the balance due and payable on same as of this date is \$210.75.
 Both of said mortgages cover the premises hereinabove described
 and are of record in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
