is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. A. Wallace: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the corner of Perry and Lawton Avenue and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: beginning at an iron pin on Perry Avenue (now cor. Lawton Avenue) thence along Perry Avenue $S. 71\frac{1}{2} E.$, fourteen (14) feet to an iron pin on Perry Avenue, thence $N. 18\frac{1}{2} E.$ two hundred (200) feet to an iron pin; thence $N. 71\frac{1}{2} W.$, fourteen (14) feet to an iron pin (now on Lawton Ave.) thence $S. 18\frac{1}{2} W.$, two hundred (200) feet to the beginning corner; said lot adjoins the lot described below, and is the same conveyed to J. O. Lawton Sr., by J. O. Lawton Jr., on Jan. 15, 1906, deed recorded in Vol. R.R.R., page 417, in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C.

Also: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the said City, County and State, adjoining the above described lot, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Perry Avenue, (291 feet west of the west side of Beach Street) and is the north west corner of lot formerly of W. B. Anthony now Evans, - lot #14) and runne thence with Perry Avenue $N. 41\frac{1}{2} W.$, Seventy-three (73) feet to an iron pin on Perry Avenue, corner of first lot hereinabove described; thence $N. 18\frac{1}{2} E.$, two hundred (200) feet to an iron pin; thence $S. 71\frac{1}{2} E.$, Seventy-three (73) feet to an iron pin $N. W.$, corner of said Evans' lot, #14; thence $S. 18\frac{1}{2} W.$, two hundred (200) feet to be running corner, and being lot #13 according to plat by W. A. Hudson, May 20, 1905, recorded in said office in Plat Book "Q", page 110, and conveyed to J. O. Lawton Sr. by Margaret E. Phillips Oct. 11, 1905, deed recorded in Vol. 000, at page 668.
