Cason, his heirs and assigns all that piece, percel or lot of land in Greenville Township Greenville County, South Carolina, near the western boundry of the city of Greenville, being & part of the sub-division of the City View property; beginning at a stake on Henderson Street corner of lot No. 70, and running thence in a westerly direction with line of lot No. 70 one hundred and fifty feet to a stake on a ten foot alley, thence in a southerly direction with said alley forty-eight feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 72, thence with line of Lot. No. 72 in and easterly direction one hundred and fifty feet to a stake on Henderson Street, thence with said street in a northerly direction forty-six feet to the beginning corner according to a plat made by W.A Adams and resurveyed by said Adams and being found to contain forty-six feet in place of fifty feet the place of fifty feet running with alley; known as lot No. 71 on said plat.
