KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Alfred R. Dorrah of Washington, D.C.

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, love and affection

at and before the sealing of these presents by

John F. Dorrah.

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said John F. Dorrah, his heirs and assigns forever;—All my right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate; All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and City of Greenville, Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Bynumcombe Street twenty-five feet from Echoe Street at corner of lot now or formerly of J. H. Waters, and running thence in a South westerly direction in a line parallel with Echoe Street and with Waters' line sixty-eight and one-half feet to line of lot of J. W. Gray; thence in a southeasterly direction with Gray's line fifty feet to a ten foot alley; thence with said alley in a north easterly direction sixty-eight and one-half feet to an iron pin on Bynumcombe Street, and thence with Bynumcombe Street in a north westerly direction to the beginning corner; and being the same lot of land conveyed to D. Lewis Dorrah, deceased, by Arthur L. Mills, by deed dated March 28th, 1911, and recorded in Deed Book, Vol. 6 page 294. Beginning at south east corner of Yorrice and Carrier Streets and running thence with south side of Carrier Street in a southeasterly direction one hundred and sixteen feet to iron pin on said street; thence on a line parallel with Yorrice Street, one hundred and twenty feet to point on a straight line drawn from the middle of Culvert on Yorrice Street to middle of Culvert on Main Street, distant from Yorrice Street one hundred and sixteen feet, thence in a north westerly direction on a line parallel to Carrier Street one hundred and sixteen feet to iron pin on Yorrice Street, middle of Culvert; thence with Yorrice Street one hundred and twenty feet to the beginning; and being the same lot of land conveyed to D. Lewis Dorrah by W. T. Henderson and others, by deed dated April 12th 1911 and recorded in Deed Book, Vol. -11, page 389. Also all my right, title and interest in and to the personal estate of the said D. Lewis Dorrah deceased.

It is understood and agreed as a part of the consideration of this deed that the said John F. Dorrah is to assume and pay all the debts and obligations of the estate of D. Lewis Dorrah.
