KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, David Ballenger, J. Seighton Ballenger, J. Seber Ballenger, Millard P. Ballenger, Annie Ballenger Plumbly, Sallie Ballenger and Ola Ballenger Curston of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) DOLLARS,

to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by H. J. Ward of the County aforesaid

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

H. J. Ward all our rights title and interest in all that piece parcel and tract of land situated in the State and County aforesaid and Highland Township on waters of South Tiger River lying on West side of old State Road about one mile north of Tigerville. Containing fifty acres more or less and bounded by lands of B. S. Neves, D. H. Roe, A. J. Sister, H. J. Southern and others being the same tract of land conveyed by J. J. Wood to H. J. Ward by deed bearing date the 11 day of July 1904 and Recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for said County of Greenville in Volume (232) Page 779 in which deed the courses and distances of said tract of land are set forth.
