KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I John Henry Atkinson of the City  
and County of Greenville being of unsound mind,

in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of  
One Dollar and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Victoria J. Carter

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
Victoria J. Carter, and her heirs and assigns, all my  
right, title, interest, estate, claim, and demand whatsoever  
existing at law and in equity (being an undivided  
one-half interest) in and to all that certain lot, piece  
or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State  
of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the Third  
Ward of the City of Greenville, known and designated as  
Lot No. 2 on ab West Street real estate of Joseph A. Atkin-  
son, deceased, made by John W. Carter, dated June 4,  
1906, and filed in the office of the Clerk of Court for said  
County and State in Judgment Roll # 2506 and having  
according to such plan the following lines and bounds,  
to wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Johnson  
Street one hundred (100) feet westward from the north-  
west corner of Fox and Johnson Streets, and running thence  
along said Johnson Street N. 81° W. fifty-one (51) feet to  
a stake on the corner of lot No. 3, thence along line of  
last mentioned lot N. 81° E. eighty-four (84) feet  
to a stake on a ten foot alley; thence along said alley  
N. 89 1/2° E. fifty-one and one-third (51-1/3) feet to a stake  
on the corner of lot No. 1; thence along line of last mentioned  
lot S. 9 1/2° W. ninety-three and one-half (93 1/2) feet to the  
beginning corner, this being the same lot conveyed to my  
sister Nellie Jane Atkinson (now Mrs. Nellie Jane Cole)  
and myself by J. W. Gray, Master, record bearing date  
October 3, 1906, and recorded in the office of the Registered  
of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State on March  
28, 1908, in Deed Book "U U U", at page 29.
