is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
Lawrence C. Ashmore his heirs and assigns, all of  
 that certain piece parcel and lot of land situated  
 in the State and County aforesaid on Reedy River  
 about one mile below Coopers Mill, and being lot  
 No. 4 in the division of Jacob Lenderman's Estate and  
 more fully described by a plat made by H. O. Threlkeld  
 on 14th January 1876 (and having the following metes  
 and bounds: Beginning at a Red Oak dead 3 ft. on  
 the west bank of Reedy River and running thence S. 30 W.  
 23.87 chains to a Rock 3x3x n.w. thence S. 52 1/4 E. 21.50  
 to rock 3x3x n.w. 8 links from Nickson on Reedy River  
 thence up the meanders of said river to the returning  
 point, containing forty-three acres, 3 rods and six  
 and 4/10 (or less) more or less.
