Ellen Cox, Lillie W. Adams, and Will Adams, sole
heirs-at-law of D. W. Adams, and Mary Ann Adams,
both deceased in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand and no/100 (\$1000.00) DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Lawrence C. Ashmore

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Lawrence C. Ashmore, his heirs and assigns, all
that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated
in the State and County aforesaid on Reedy River
about one mile below Coneatey Mills, and being lot
No. 4 in the division of Jacob Leudermou's Estate, and
more fully described by a plat made by W. D. Threl-
held on 14th January, 1876, and being (the following
metes and bounds: Beginning at a Red Oak, debd.
370m, on the west bank of Reedy River, and running
thence S. 30° E. 23.87 chains to a rock 37 37 1/2m., thence
S. 52 1/4° E. 21.50 to rock 37 37 1/2m., 8 links from Nickow
on Reedy River), thence up the meander of said
river to the beginning point, containing forty-three
acres, 3 Rods and six and 4/10 Poles, more or less.
