County of Greenville }KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That D. T. Smith of County and
State aforesaidin the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of
Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by T. G. Sharpe of said County and State

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said T. G. Sharpe, and his heirs and assigns, all, that certain piece parcel and lot of land, laying and being in the County and State aforesaid and in what is now known as West Greenville, and being Lot No. 8 in a Survey and plan of land known as Pendleton Annex, which said tract is recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at page 178, reference thereto being made for a more particular description, Said lot No. 8 beginning at a stake on corner of twenty foot street and running thence along Pendleton Road fifty feet to a stake ^{on} corner of lot No. 7, thence at right angles with said Pendleton Road one hundred and forty feet to a stake on lot No. 9, thence thirty-nine feet and six inches to a stake on said twenty foot street, thence along said street to a stake one hundred thirty feet and three inches in his to beginning corner, Also all that other lot of land adjoining to the aforesaid lot and being known as lot No. 9 in the aforesaid tract and beginning at a stake on said twenty foot street at corner of lot No. 8 and running thence along the back line of lot No. 8 and 76 feet - eight feet and eight inches to a stake on line of lot No. 7, thence one hundred twenty-eight feet to a stake on said street, thence along said street forty-seven feet to a stake on said thirty foot street, thence along said twenty foot street one hundred twenty-one feet, and seven inches to the beginning corner. Both of said lots being parts of a larger lot of land conveyed to me by Mrs. A. C. and T. W. Horner and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 28 at pages 339 and 340.
