J. W. Deasey, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in
the County and State aforesaid, containing the following
metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the Mosetta Road
and running thence $\frac{1}{4}$ S. $88\frac{1}{4}$ E. 31.06 chds. to a
stone, thence N. 5 E. 15.10 chds. to a stone, thence N. 86 $\frac{1}{4}$
W. 31.42 chds. to a stone on the said Mosetta Road,
thence with the road 15.74 chds. to beginning corner,
containing 3.6 acres, more or less.

Also all that other piece, parcel or tract of land
situated as aforesaid, having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at a corner on Mosetta Road
and running back with said road 4.35 chds. to a
