is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Annie E. Heer, all that certain lot of land situate in Ward One, City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Neal Street, one hundred-forty (140) feet from the intersection of Townes and said Neal Streets; running thence parallel with Townes Street South 21-30 West one hundred-eleven (111) feet to an iron pin on rear lot no. 8, and on ten-foot alley; thence with said alley north 76° west forty-six (46) feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 9½; thence with joint line of lots nos. 9½ and 8½ north 18-15 East one hundred-ten (110) feet and four (4) inches to Neal Street; thence Southeast with Neal Street fifty-two (52) feet and seven (7) inches to beginning corner, and being lot no. 8½ according to a plat of W. D. Brownings lot made by W. B. Neve, which said plat is recorded in Plat Book b, page 44, in R. M. L. office for said Greenville County, the above being a part of a lot of land deeded to W. D.
