KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Irene B. Neslitt,

in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 W.H. Ballantine, his Heirs and assigns:

All that lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, on the South side of Suncombe Street; Beginning at an iron pin on Suncombe Street at the corner of this and lot no. 4, and running thence S. 56 W. 150 feet to an iron pin corner of this and lot no. 4, thence N. 34 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Suncombe Street; thence along Suncombe Street S. 34 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner; being the lot of land conveyed to me by Seila Madden January 4th, 1916; deed recorded in Vol. 38, page 431, and known as lot no. 5.

Also all that other lot of land in said City, County and state, situate on the north side of Suncombe Street; Beginning at an iron pin on Suncombe Street, at W.F. Sonville's corner and running thence with Sonville's line N. 54 E. 186 feet to an iron pin on lot formerly belonging to J.S. Maxwell; thence with the line of said Maxwell lot, N. 29 W. 70 1/3 feet to an iron pin on J. Attonis line; thence S. 57 W. 194 feet to an iron pin on Suncombe Street; thence with Suncombe Street S. 33 3/4 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner; being the lot of land conveyed to me by J. H. Eakins by deed dated the 18th day of January, 1913; deed recorded in Vol. 24, page 521.

As a part of the consideration of this deed, the grantee herein assumes and will pay that certain note and mortgage executed by the grantor to Piedmont Savings & Investment Company, for Fifty-four Hundred Dollars, dated the 4th day of January, 1916, with all interest accrued and to become due, as per the terms of said note; said mortgage recorded in Vol. 38, at page 288, in R.M.B. office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
