"Grace Holly claim"

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situated lying and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, in Chick Spring Township, on Escocee River and the new Brushy Creek Road, and having the following boundaries and dimensions, according to plat by Miss. D. Nease, Enger of the Eva L. and J. H. Holly claim estate, bearing date of the 3rd day of September, 1914 to wit:

Beginning at a point on the east side of Escocee River, corner of tract No. 5, and running thence N. 22.30 E. 20.20 to a stake, in the forks of two branches; thence N. 46 W. 11.85 to an iron pin; thence N. 26.45 W. 8.58 to another iron pin in the new Brushy Creek Road; thence up said road to the line S. 34.10 W. 5.74 to another iron pin in said road; thence in a southeasterly direction 3.55 to a stone; thence S. 8 W. 25.40 to a stake on Escocee River; thence down said river following the meanders thereof to the line 12.00 to the beginning corner and known and designated as tract No. 4 on the plat hereinabove mentioned and contains thirty-eight acres, and bounded by tract three and five and by lands of S. H. Jarrea and H. B. Holly claim and Escocee River.
