is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. S. Cooper and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in County, Township, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by W. E. Dalton, Surveyor, dated January 1917, to wit:

The beginning at an iron pin on the edge of a public road, one like of Norah B. McDaniel and B. P. Mitchell property, and running thence with line of said Mitchell Land N. 45-45 R. 1815 feet to a iron pin on line of Robert Remond land; thence with line of said Land N. 85-45 R. 1815 feet to a stone on line of Elizabeth M. Cleveland land; thence with line of Elizabeth M. Cleveland land S. 5-0 W. 740 feet to a stake corner of W. D. Earle land; thence with line of W. D. Earle land S. 85 E. 1384 feet to a stone; thence with line of same land S. 4.05 E. 1440 feet to a stake near a public road; thence with line of Norah B. McDaniel land N. 85-30 E. 889 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 5.980 acres, more or less.

This being a portion of the same land Conveyed to me, the said G. C. Richardson by Henry L. Bell by a deed dated 3rd day of Feby. 1916, and Recorded in the R. M. C. office for said County and State in Volume # 38 of Deeds, at page 554.
