(the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

C. M. Todd, all that piece, parcel or lot of land
situate lying and being in the Township of Chick
Springs, Greenville County and State of South Car-
olina, having the following metes and bounds:-
beginning at a stake on the North west side
of the National Highway and the sub-division
of the said E. M. Wharton near Paris, S.C. corner of
lot number 74, and running thence along said
National Highway N. 60-16 E. Twenty five feet to a
stake on said National Highway and corner
of lot number 76, thence N. 29-44 W. fifty feet to a
stake in the line of lot number 73, thence
running along line of said lot number 73 S.
60-16 W. twenty five feet to a stake in said line
and corner of lot number 74, thence S. 29-44 E.
fifty feet to a stake at the beginning corner, This
