Five Thousand (\$500.00) DOLLARS,
 to the Southern Textile Exposition Co. in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by Southern Textile Exposition Co.,
Corporation of South Carolina.

(the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
Southern Textile Exposition, Incorporated: All that certain
 parcel or strip of land measuring five (5) feet in width and
 approximately eighty-nine (89) feet in length cut off from the
 Western or rear end of my residence lot situated in Ward One
 on the West side of North Academy Street in the city of Greenville,
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina, the said strip being
 described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of my
 said lot, being former Moore's corner, running thence N. 26-45'
 E. 89 7/10 feet, thence S. 68-50 E. five feet, thence S. 26-45 West 88 7/10 feet,
 thence N. 70-30 W. five feet to the beginning corner.
 As a part of the consideration of this deed, it is agreed between
 the grantor and the grantee that the grantor, her heirs and
 assigns, as the owner of the adjoining property, shall have
 the right in perpetuity to use the above described premises
 and the premises conveyed to the grantee by D.W. Moore as
 an alley way leading into West Washington Street.
