NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I J. A. Mc Kinney of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of four hundred and sixty four DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. B. League of the same place

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. B. League: all that lot or two parcel of land lying being and situate in County and State aforesaid, one containing ten acres, more or less, the same land conveyed to me by Mrs. F. E. Nunvalley on the 21 day of March 1904 and recorded in Vol L. L. L page 582 in Register Messrs Conveyance office at Greenville and hath the following metes and bounds to wit: Commencing at a stone S 83 W 7.16 to a stone; thence S 4 3/4 W 14.00 to a stone; thence N. 83 E 7.16 to a stone; thence N. 4 3/4 E 14.00 to beginning corner. Also one other lot at the same place containing one and six tenths acres more or less, the same being a part of the land conveyed to me by James P. Hughes on the 6 day of March 1901 and recorded the fourth day of May 1901 in Vol I. I. I page 67 in Register Messrs Conveyance office at Greenville S. C. and commences on a stone and running thence S 83 3/4 W 3.40 to a stone; thence N. 4 3/4 E 5.00 to a stone thence N. 83 3/4 E. 3.40 to a stone thence S 44 W 5.00 to beginning corner.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

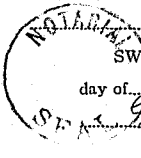

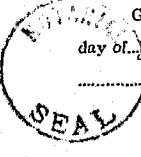
