

W. W. Forest DEED TO J. D. Bridges

 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. W. Forest of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars and no part of the same DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Bridges,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. D. Bridges, all that certain tract of land in the State and County aforesaid, in Cleveland Township within the Parish of South Carolina, bounded and on the lot road leading from Caesar's Road South into the Marietta and Oumpkintown Road, containing three hundred (300) acres, more or less known as the Evans tract of land bounded on the north by Hawkins' Land (formerly Hagood home tract); on the east by Johnson Land Company, or Saluda River Land Company (as the same); on the south by Matthew (or Ann D.) Fortner's land, on the west by lands known as the home tract, being the same land acquired by the said J. D. Bridges and W. W. Forest from Saluda Ettrude Hagood, Sarah Annita Hagood, William Clarence Hagood, Eva Caroline Hagood, Areda and John Benjamin Hagood on March 11th 1916 by deed from said Hagoods to said grantor and grantees; and the said W. W. Forest hereby conveys all his right, title and interest in said tract of land, which is an undivided one-half interest therein; the said J. D. Bridges being the owner of the other half, so that this deed vests in him a full and complete title in and to said land in fee simple. The above land is also known as the William Evans land.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. D. Bridges, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. D. Bridges, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
