NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That A. L. Adams  
in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Five and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Elizabeth W. Stansell

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Elizabeth W. Stansell, her heirs and assigns, with that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville City, and two in Springwood Cemetery, and having the following dimensions, to wit: N. 11° E. 13' S. 11° W. 12' and being known and designated as lot # 408 in the plot of Springwood Cemetery.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto, that this conveyance is made subject to the conditions and limitations as to the use of said lot for a place of burial as is expressed in the deed to me.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Elizabeth W. Stansell and her heirs and assigns, forever.

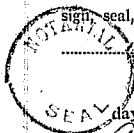
