-NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I J. M. Markley Jr. of City of
Macon, County of Dale and State of Florida in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. M. Trotter, Jr.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

M. M. Trotter Jr. all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and City of Greenville, on the north side of Earle Street, beginning at a point or stake on Earle Street one hundred and thirty feet and eight inches west from the north west corner of Earle and Bennett Streets, and running thence N. 15. 30 E. one hundred forty-four feet more or less, to a stake on Swiss Ave, thence N 66. 15 W, sixty five feet eight inches to a stake, thence South 18. 30 W. one hundred fifty feet more or less to a stake on Earle Street, thence with Earle Street S. 71. 20 E. sixty five feet four inches to the beginning corner, being lot No. 16 Sec. "F" of a plat of the Stone Land Company, made by J. E. Irvine, June 4th, 1909, said plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Plat Book A, pp 337-345. This being the same lot of land conveyed to N. A. Williams by Fannie P. Stone by deed bearing date July, 20, 1914, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Vol. 27, page 188. M. M. Trotter Jr. is to assume a mortgage of \$200.00 over the above lot, and interest on same beginning Nov. 1, 1917.

AND I do hereby bind myself & my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said M. M. Trotter, Jr.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

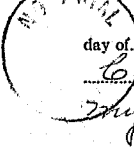
