Brashier all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Grove Township State and County aforesaid, and containing the following more or less acre and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin ¹¹⁸³⁹ 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. on bank of creek and running thence S. 44¹/₂ W. 18.09 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 chains to a black gum on public road; thence along said road S. 2¹/₂ E. 6. 97 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 chains to a stake; thence S. 80-40 W. 6. 53 chains to an iron pin ^{1524.6} 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 on another road; thence N. 6. 00-^{534.6} W. 23.10 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02; thence N. 85¹/₂ E. 8. 1. 0 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 on said road; thence N. 77¹/₂ E. 12. 75 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 on the public road first above mentioned; thence S. 23¹/₂ E. 5. 06 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02; thence N. 88-^{85.6} E. 13. 01 chains to an iron pin 3¹/₂ N. 7¹/₂ W. 14.02 on the bank of the creek first above mentioned; thence along said creek following the meanders thereof as a line in a southeasterly direction 5¹/₂ links to the beginning corner.
