NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Augustas W. Smith,

*in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and One Hundred and Two Dollars,
and other valuable considerations, I da A. Aiken*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Ida A. Aiken, all that certain lot or parcel of land situate in Ward Five in the City of Greenville South Carolina, on the North side of Pendleton Street, and known as No. 1512; bounded on the west by lot of J. M. Sittor; on the east by lot of Marion B. Leach (formerly C. C. Spain); and having the following lines and bounds: Beginning at corner of lot of J. M. Sittor, thence along Pendleton Street east thirty feet to lot of Marion B. Leach (formerly Spain); thence along Leach's line two hundred feet to corner; thence parallel with Pendleton Street ninety feet to Sittor's line; thence with said line two hundred feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Walter M. Scott, Judge of Probate by deed dated October 9th, 1917, recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 8, page 176.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Ida A. Aiken, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Ida A. Aiken, her heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same, or any part thereof.
