(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. F. Norton, All that piece parcel and tract of land lying, situate and being in Paris Mt. Township State and County aforesaid. Known as a part of the land conveyed to us by deed from O. B. Hartzog adjoining land of our selves and George M^e Carter and others. Beginning on a stone S. W. corner thence running S. 68° 14. 04 to a stake Poplar gone, thence N. 42° E. 11. 60 to an iron pin thence N. 21 1/2° W. 15. 00 to an iron pin n.w. thence S. 87 1/2° W. 12 to a Station on George M^e Carters line thence S 33 1/4° E. 20. 33 to a stone, thence S 16° E. 7. 10 to the beginning corner and contains (20) twenty acres more or less.
