NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, G.G. Slaughter
in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of \$100.00 and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
L.D. Huff

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
L.D. Huff, his heirs and assigns forever, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the
County of Greenville: Beginning at an iron pipe on the south side of Prentiss Avenue, 65 ft.
from Elm Street and the corner of Lot No. 12, Block L., on plat of the subdivision of the
property of O.P. Mills; thence along the south side of Prentiss Avenue S. 45-27 W. 65 ft. to
an iron pipe, corner of lot No. 10; thence with the line of lot No. 10, South 44-33 East
180 ft. to an iron pipe on the back line of lots; thence north 45-27 East 65 ft. to iron
pipe corner of lot No. 12; thence with line of lot No. 12, North 44-33 West 180 feet to the
iron pipe on the south side of Prentiss Avenue at the point of beginning. Said lot
being known as lot No. 11, Block L., on plat of property of O.P. Mills made May 1914 by
R.E. Dalton, Asst. Engineer to H.Olin Jones, Greenville, S.C. this being the same lot
