NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Robert D Woodside, of Greenville S C

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs Ola Young Henry

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs Ola Young Henry; All certain piece, parcel of lot of land, situate lying and being in the City of Greenville and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being a portion of the Rowley Place and having the following metes and bounds: Commencing at a stake on North Street, joint corners of lots nos 3 and 4 and running thence N. 76° 30' E with North Street sixty one feet and four inches to a stake joint corners of lots nos 2 and 3 thence N 21° 45' E one hundred and eighty feet to a stake on ten foot alley; thence S 76° 30' E along said alley sixty one feet and four inches to a stake at joint corner of lots Nos 3 and 4; thence S 21° 45' E one hundred and eighty feet to a stake at the beginning, same being lot No 3, according to a survey made by E. A. Adams, January 1910. The deed conveying this property to my being recorded in book 9 page 241, R.M. C. Greenville County.
