Avenue in the fifth Ward of the City of Greenville
Known and designated as Lot No. 5 of the Furman
University property, as shown on plan made by
J. S. Rogers, Surveyor, and recorded in the R. M. C.

and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at a Stake on the South side of C. Choice
Avenue at the north-east corner of Lot # 6 sold
to L. B. Martin and running thence with C. Choice
Avenue S. 89. 40 E. 80 feet to Stake corner Lot # 4;
thence 77th line of lot # 4 due S. 250 feet to stake
