in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Harry Poole

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Grafted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Harry Poole, all that certain piece, parcel of tract of land situate, lying and being in Bates Township, County and State aforesaid, on the bank waters of Enoree River, adjoining lands of J. W. Hayward, B. F. Hunt and others, containing Twenty Four (24) acres more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit, Beginning on a stone on Thomas Childs line, and running thence S. 13, E. 4, 00 chs. to a stone, thence S. 67 1/2 E. 8. 25 chs. to a Chestnut thence, S. 62 E. 10. 40 chs. to a stone, thence N. 36 1/2 E. 13. 36 chs. to a dogwood, thence N. 24. 3/4 W. 5. 50 chs. to a pine 3/4 N. 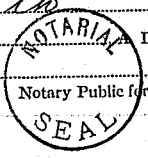

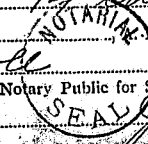
