(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J.B. Rasor, All those two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville. First lot being situate on the north side of East Earle Street and fronting on said Street sixty feet with a depth of One Hundred forty feet, more or less and being lot No. 21, of Sect. F., of a plat of Stone Land Company, said plat being recorded in plat book A., at page 337-345. Second lot being situate on the south side of East Earle Street and fronting on said Street sixty feet with a depth of Two hundred six feet and six inches and being lot No. 7, of Sect.
